During the meeting, Dafna Wu, RN, along with youth from the Dimensions Clinic, will focus on issues related to the care of gender transitioning youth ages 16-26. Such issues will include client based clinic care, hormone therapy, psychosocial assessment, clinical and psychological support and staff development and education, protocol design.

After this training, participants will:

- 1) be able to define and understand the terms "gender", "sex" and "sexual orientation" and how these identities contribute to a healthy self-image;
- 2) be able to name three barriers to healthcare for transgender youth;
- 3) be able to give three examples of how to make their clinic space friendlier to transgender youth;
- 4) name two resources for provider training and two resources for transgender youth support in the Bay Area; and
- 5) be able to name hormones commonly prescribed for female-to-male and male-to female transgender youth.
